Mahi Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc Marlborough, New Zealand Mahi means "our craft" in Maori, aptly named by the owner & winemaker Brian Bicknell who learnt his craft in France and brings a level of elengance and finesse to New Zealand. This Sauvignon has musky aromas of lemon-lime, pepper and herbs, while still retaining a subtle suggestion of ripe peach and gooseberry.	34

	California, USA An expressive American Chardonnay with both power and finesse. The wine spent 9 months in oak barrels and has a brilliant, mouthfilling texture. Expect plenty of stone fruit and citrus alongside subtle notes of vanilla and smoke from the oa	k.
19.	Chablis Domaine Sainte Claire, Jean-Marc Brocard (Organic) Burgundy, France The domaine of Jean-Marc Brocard began as just one hectare a wedding gift from his father-in-law when he married into a winegrowing family. He has since expanded and is widely recognised as one of Chablis's leading producers. His approac is one of minimal intervention in both vineyard and winery. Expect a fresh nose with aromas citrus fruits and an elegant minerality. The palate is round with a beautiful creamy texture	h
20.	Sancerre La Croix du Roy, Domaine Crochet Loire, France A classic Sancerre, with aromas of currants and grapefuit; a dry, elegant palate with a layer of minerality and a neat, focused finish.	48

28. Côtes-du-Rhône Samorëns rouge, Ferraton Rhône, France

Medium to full-bodied. The palate is full of bright, fresh cherry and berry fruit, lifted by floral, peppery aromas and savoury, earthy undertones. The tannins are silky and well rounded with a firm, fresh finish.

Red Wines **Bottle** BY THE BOTTLE 29. Pinot Noir Les Parcs, Guy Allion, Loire, France An elegnat yet vibrant Pinot Noir with a good deal of finesse. Plenty of ripe strawberries, raspberries and cranberry with subtle woody notes thanks to a few months in old oak barrels. 30. Reserve du Couvent Rouge, Château Ksara Bekaa Valley, Lebanon Château Ksara is Lebanon's oldest winery. Winemaking began in 1857 when the estate was inherited by Jesuit monks who planted and farmed the vines. An awardwinning blend of Syrah, Cabernet Sauvignon and Cabernet Franc - big, full and powerful. Expect flavours of black cherries laced with black pepper and vanilla that create a mouth-filling texture. 31. Rioja Reserva, Conde Valdemar, Rioja, Spain 38.5 A wonderfully complex wine that has spent 27 months in both French and American oak barrels. The wine has numerous layers of flavour with subtle spicy notes and ripe black fruit touches. Expect a generous, intense palate full of plums, black cherry, raisins and chocolate. A beautiful balance of fruit and oak, with a long, persistent finish. 32. Pulenta Estate I Malbec, Mendoza, Argentina A serious and powerful Malbec. The nose explodes with red and black fruits alongside appealing floral notes. The palate is well-rounded with a fruit profile that blends freshness and intensity. Oak ageing has lent a spicy character to the wine and there is a complex mineral streak through the core. 33. Crozes-Hermitage La Matinière rouge, Ferraton, Rhône, France This rich, cherry red Crozes Hermitage wine has a nose of small red fruits and blackcurrants, smoke and spice. An expressive and perfumed 100% Syrah, with notes of succulent black cherry, toast and subtle violets. The tannins are silky and in perfect balance with the fresh acidity. Partly matured in Oak barrels for 12 months before
