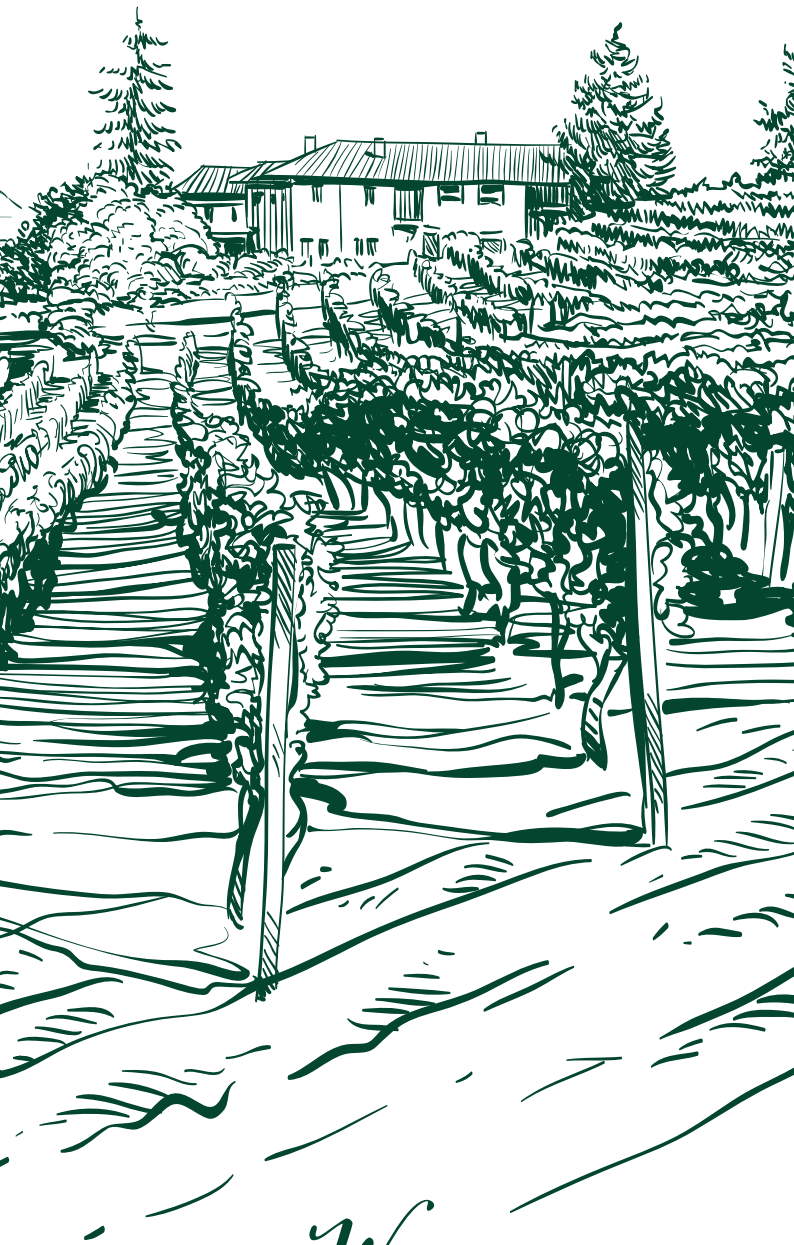

07. **Kleinkloof Chenin Blanc** 19.95
Western Cape, South Africa
Delicious flavours of tropical fruit, pineapple and guava with a hint of citrus; very attractive nose and a crisp, refreshing palate.

08. **Etnia Sauvignon Blanc, Mancura** 20.5
Valle Central, Chile
A clean and fresh Sauvignon Blanc. The nose offers tantalising tropical fruit aromas and white flowers.

09. **Pionero Chardonnay Reserva, Morandé** 22.25
Colchagua Valley, Chile
A bright, citrusy aroma with pear and green apple. Medium-bodied and nicely rounded, returning to citrus on the finish.

10. **Pinot Grigio delle Dolomiti, Terre del Noce** 24
Trentino, Italy
An elegant, dry Pinot Grigio with flavours of apple, pear and a hint of melon. Gently floral nose with a clean finish.

11. **Conde Valdemar Rioja Blanco, Rioja, Spain** 26
Wonderful aromas of peach, melon, pear and acacia flowers with subtle notes of almond. Delicious and crisp white wine, perfect with seafood and summer salads.

12. **Soñadora Organic Verdejo, Castilla y Leon, Spain** 23
Soñadora, which means “day dreamer” in Spanish, is organically farmed in vineyards situated in the high plains of La Mancha. Expect delicious aromas of freshly cut grass and exotic fruits with notes of apples and pears.
13. **Foxwood Dawn Picked Viognier, Languedoc, France** 23.5
A classic Viognier with flavours of ripe apricot, nectarine and summer flowers. Medium in body, with a soft texture and a refreshing streak of citrus, this is summer in a glass.
14. **Feudo Arancio Grillo, Sicily, Italy** 24.5
An award-winning wine made from 100% Grillo, an indigenous grape variety to Sicily. Bursting with tropical notes of mango and papaya with hints of jasmine and acacia flowers. The palate is round, textured and beautifully aromatic.
15. **White Rabbit Riesling, Rhein, Germany** 28.5
A dry but fruity Riesling with a surprising amount of tropical fruit as well as the typical flavours of apple and citrus. The nose has subtle notes of cut grass and petrol that brings an extra layer of complexity to this balanced and refreshing wine. Pairs well with spicy dishes.

16. **Mahi Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc** 34
Marlborough, New Zealand
Mahi means “our craft” in Maori, aptly named by the owner & winemaker Brian Bicknell who learnt his craft in France and brings a level of elegance and finesse to New Zealand. This Sauvignon has musky aromas of lemon-lime, pepper and herbs, while still retaining a subtle suggestion of ripe peach and gooseberry.
17. **Gavi di Gavi La Meirana, Broglia, Piedmont, Italy** 36
A beautiful wine with great texture and precision from the renowned Broglia Estate. Expect a palate full of orchard fruits, distinctive green apple and almond notes and a charming mineral streak. Fresh and dry, this is particularly characterful Gavi.
18. **North Coast Chardonnay, Buena Vista** 39
California, USA
An expressive American Chardonnay with both power and finesse. The wine spent 9 months in oak barrels and has a brilliant, mouthfilling texture. Expect plenty of stone fruit and citrus alongside subtle notes of vanilla and smoke from the oak.
19. **Chablis Domaine Sainte Claire, Jean-Marc Brocard (Organic) Burgundy, France** 45
The domaine of Jean-Marc Brocard began as just one hectare; a wedding gift from his father-in-law when he married into a winegrowing family. He has since expanded and is widely recognised as one of Chablis's leading producers. His approach is one of minimal intervention in both vineyard and winery. Expect a fresh nose with aromas citrus fruits and an elegant minerality. The palate is round with a beautiful creamy texture.
20. **Sancerre La Croix du Roy, Domaine Crochet** 48
Loire, France
A classic Sancerre, with aromas of currants and grapefruit; a dry, elegant palate with a layer of minerality and a neat, focused finish.

04. **Nina Pinot Grigio Rosé, Veneto, Italy** 19.95
A dry yet fruity rosé, brimming with flavours of wild strawberry, raspberry and citrus. Pale and refreshing.

05. **Golden State Zinfandel Rosé, California, USA** 22.25
This Californian rosé has a nose full of juicy red berries. A sweeter flavour profile gives way to a palate of watermelon, strawberries and raspberries.

06. **Saint-Roch Les Vignes Rosé, Maîtres Vignerons de Saint Tropez, Côtes de Provence, France** 29.5
Provence is the only wine region in the world that specialises in rosé wine. This is a pale, salmon-pink rosé with beautiful flavours of white peach and lychee. Lively and refreshing with a long, lingering finish.

21. **Valdemoreda Tempranillo**, 19.95
Castilla La Mancha, Spain
A cracking wine that punches well above its weight. Plenty of strawberry, blackcurrant and cherry with a wonderfully fragrant nose. Full-bodied and fresh.

22. **First Fleet Shiraz**, Victoria, Australia 21
A soft and juicy wine with masses of black cherry fruit, a smooth, round texture and a touch of peppery, spice classic of Montepulciano.

23. **Terre del Noce Merlot delle Dolomiti**
Trentino, Italy 22.25
A smooth, easy-drinking Merlot with plum and red cherry fruit, and a hint of dark chocolate on the finish.

24. **Codici Masserie Primitivo**, Puglia, Italy 23.5
Velvety smooth yet full bodied with delicious flavours of dried berries, redcurrant and a warming sweet spice.

25. **Finca La Colonia Colección Malbec, Bodegas Norton**, Mendoza, Argentina 26.5
Edmund Norton was an English engineer who moved to Argentina to help build the Transandine Railway from Mendoza to Santiago, Chile in the 1880s. After completion of the railway he settled in Mendoza and planted the very first vines in the region; Malbec vines imported from France. This Malbec has aromas of ripe red fruit, cassis and black pepper with a touch of spice. Elegant and smooth with a long finish.

26. **Château Barade, Bordeaux** 26
(Merlot/Cabernet Sauvignon) Bordeaux, France
An award winning Bordeaux from a small, family run Château. Deep ruby red in colour with plenty of dark berry flavours, hints of cassis and liquorice. Medium bodied with soft, round tannins and an elegant, refreshing finish.
27. **Cassa Douro Tinto**, Douro, Portugal 27
Tantalising aromas of red fruits and rose petal. Full-bodied with notes of juicy redcurrants and raspberries on the palate with a touch of spice on the long, flavoursome finish.
28. **Côtes-du-Rhône Samorëns rouge, Ferraton** 28.5
Rhône, France
Medium to full-bodied. The palate is full of bright, fresh cherry and berry fruit, lifted by floral, peppery aromas and savoury, earthy undertones. The tannins are silky and well rounded with a firm, fresh finish.

29. **Pinot Noir Les Parcs, Guy Allion**, Loire, France 31
An elegant yet vibrant Pinot Noir with a good deal of finesse. Plenty of ripe strawberries, raspberries and cranberry with subtle woody notes thanks to a few months in old oak barrels.
30. **Reserve du Couvent Rouge, Château Ksara** 33
Bekaa Valley, Lebanon
Château Ksara is Lebanon's oldest winery. Winemaking began in 1857 when the estate was inherited by Jesuit monks who planted and farmed the vines. An award-winning blend of Syrah, Cabernet Sauvignon and Cabernet Franc - big, full and powerful. Expect flavours of black cherries laced with black pepper and vanilla that create a mouth-filling texture.
31. **Rioja Reserva, Conde Valdemar**, Rioja, Spain 38.5
A wonderfully complex wine that has spent 27 months in both French and American oak barrels. The wine has numerous layers of flavour with subtle spicy notes and ripe black fruit touches. Expect a generous, intense palate full of plums, black cherry, raisins and chocolate. A beautiful balance of fruit and oak, with a long, persistent finish.
32. **Pulenta Estate I Malbec**, Mendoza, Argentina 40
A serious and powerful Malbec. The nose explodes with red and black fruits alongside appealing floral notes. The palate is well-rounded with a fruit profile that blends freshness and intensity. Oak ageing has lent a spicy character to the wine and there is a complex mineral streak through the core.
33. **Crozes-Hermitage La Matinière rouge, Ferraton**, Rhône, France 42
This rich, cherry red Crozes Hermitage wine has a nose of small red fruits and blackcurrants, smoke and spice. An expressive and perfumed 100% Syrah, with notes of succulent black cherry, toast and subtle violets. The tannins are silky and in perfect balance with the fresh acidity. Partly matured in Oak barrels for 12 months before bottling gives the wine a long and harmonious finish.

34. **Mahi Marlborough Pinot Noir** 48
Marlborough, New Zealand
Mahi means "our craft" in Maori, aptly named by the owner & winemaker Brian Bicknell who learnt his craft in France and brings a level of elegance and finesse to New Zealand. This Pinot Noir is mouth-filling, ripe and supple with good complexity and a full, rich yet detailed bouquet. Dark cherries and plums combine with soft tannins to give a well-rounded finish.

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35. **Monteagudo Pedro Ximénez, Delgado Zuleta** | Jerez, Spain 27
The grapes are picked in early September, then laid out on mats to dry under the sun, concentrating sugar levels. The resulting wine was then aged in old sherry butts for over 10 years. The palate is very soft, warm and sweet, with flavours of raisin, dried fruit and caramel.
36. **La Fleur d'Or, Sauternes** 31
Bordeaux, France
Rich and lusciously sweet; full and rounded with flavours of apricot and dried citrus fruit. A wonderful partner to cheese boards.
